
Dear Chief Reggie Burgess:

Criteria: High school senior (in Charleston, Berkley or Dorchester County) who has been accepted to an institution of higher learning and must produce a letter of acceptance or a college student with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and active in community service.

Students applying for the William Parson Scholarship must meet the following qualifications for consideration:

- be currently enrolled as a High School Senior or currently enrolled in an accredited
- college or university; have a cumulative 2.5 grade-point average for all course work to date; demonstrate merit and a need deserving of the financial support;
